How and where can I get a COVID-19 test in the Tucson area?

What should I expect?









What to expect when getting a COVID-19 test:

On these pages, you'll find lots of details about how, where, and when you can get a COVID-19 test in Tucson. Keep in mind that some of these details may change, so make sure to call or visit the website of the location that you'd like to visit first, if possible.

Some basics:

- Most of the testing sites listed here are free
- Most of these locations require appointments
- Some locations offer only drive-through service and require that you stay in your vehicle. At the testing site, either a healthcare worker will reach into your car and perform the test for you or you will be asked to do it yourself and given clear instructions for doing so
- Locations offering walk-in testing require social distancing
- You will be required to wear a face mask in all of these testing sites walk-up and drive through except when you are being given the COVID-19 test
- You will never be asked to reveal health information apart from your COVID-19 symptoms (if any) and any health conditions that you have that could make you more at-risk from COVID-19.
- You will never be asked about your or your family's immigration status.

What to expect when getting a COVID-19 test:

There are three kinds of tests: Rapid (also called "antigen"), PCR, and antibody

Rapid (antigen) tests and PCR tests detect whether you *currently have COVID-19*. They are also sometimes called "diagnostic" tests because they can help diagnose you with COVID-19.

Antibody tests detect whether you have *previously* had COVID-19 in the past few months. Antibody tests *will not* tell you if you currently have COVID-19.

Rapid (antigen) tests

- Will provide results in between 15 minutes and a few hours
- Are not as reliable as PCR tests
- Will not detect COVID-19 as well in asymptomatic individuals (those without COVID-19 symptoms) as those with symptoms
- May need to be repeated

PCR tests

- Will *usually* provide results within 48-72 hours
- Are more reliable than rapid (antigen) tests

Scheduling COVID-19 tests for children and teenagers

In Tucson:

- Children under the age of 2 must visit an urgent care clinic, hospital ER, or established healthcare provider's office for testing. The child will be assessed by a healthcare provider before testing is conducted. Call the clinic, hospital, or healthcare provider's office if you have questions about insurance coverage or cost.
- Children ages 2+ can be tested for a fee, without a healthcare assessment but by appointment, at Rescue Me Wellness (more info <u>here</u>; register <u>here</u>)
- Children and youth ages 5+ can be tested for free, without a healthcare assessment but by appointment, at the following locations (see slides for more information on each site):
 - All Pima County testing sites (Kino Events Center, Udall Park, Ellie Town/ Flowing Wells Community Center, TEP Building/ PCHD Downtown, Tucson International Airport)
 - All ASU/ADHS testing sites (Pima Community College West, Pima Community College Desert Vista, Pima Community College East, 400 W. Congress St parking garage)

Scheduling COVID-19 tests for children and teenagers:

Registering your child or guardee for a test with Pima County:

- If you have already registered yourself on the Labfinder/ Paradigm Laboratories webpage (available here and on these slides), after you select the appointment time and location for your child you will log in with your own login information
- If you do not already have an account for yourself, create that account before attempting to register your child or guardee for a test
- You will be asked a series of screening questions. No matter your answers, you/ your child are still eligible for the test
- Following that, you will be asked whether you are registering yourself or someone else for the test - select "someone else." You will be asked to input their information.
- Following that, you will click the button "book appointment" and you're done!

Registering your child or guardee for a test with ASU/ADHS:

- Every individual being tested must have their own login information. You will be asked to provide an email address for each individual. Parents/ guardians can use their own email addresses for children but each child must be associated with a different email address.
- Once you have created an account for your child (go here to register), the site will ask you whether you want to "Schedule or view my appointments" or "View my lab results" - select "Schedule or view my appointments" and then "Schedule an appointment."
- You will be asked to enter your mailing address. Then, press the green "Continue" button.
- You can select date and location from the drop-down boxes on the following page and then press "Search for appointments." Note that many of these locations are in Phoenix – make sure to select one of the Pima Community College locations. Also note that these locations are closed between Dec 23, 2020 and Jan 1, 2021


Free Pima County COVID-19 testing sites

What to expect at a Pima County COVID-19 testing site:

- Appointments are required for all Pima Co testing sites (schedule <u>here</u>). Individuals 5 years and older are eligible. *Double-check testing sites and days <u>here</u>*.
- 2. Face masks must be worn at all times except for the moment in which your COVID-19 test is being conducted
- 3. Upon arrival, you will be asked whether you are experiencing symptoms of COVID-19. If you are, you will be sent to the "symptoms" line. If not, you will be sent to the "no symptoms" line, at a separate entrance.
- 4. You will wait in line at a safe distance from others; spots are marked on the floor 6 ft apart from each other. You must enter alone *unless* you need assistance. Elderly adults and children can be accompanied.
- 5. After entering, your temperature will be taken. If it is elevated, and you said that you had "no symptoms," you may be sent to the "symptoms" line. This does not mean that you have COVID-19; it is just a safety measure.

- 6. You will be asked your name; you do <u>not</u> need to present a driver's license
- 7. At the next station, you will be given some papers with information about COVID-19, including how to contact others who you may have infected *if* the results of your test are positive for COVID-19.
- 8. When the test is conducted, you will briefly pull your mask down under your nose (keeping your mouth covered). A swab similar in appearance to a long q-tip will be placed high inside your nose and moved around gently for several seconds. You may feel as if you need to sneeze or cough; this is common. Both nostrils will be swabbed.
- 9. After the test, you will pull your mask back up over your nose and you're done! Results are generally available at the web address that officials provide you with in about 72 hrs (3 business days).



TO REGISTER FOR TESTING AT ANY ASU/ ADHS TESTING SITE:

Schedule your appointment using a cell phone, tablet, or computer using these steps:

- Log in: https://asubioempportal.pointnclick.com/
- Enter agency code: SALIVATEST
- Once logged-in to the portal, click on "Appointments" to make your appointment - you will be asked to pick a date and a testing location. After scheduling your appointment, you will receive a bar code – you will need this for your appointment, so consider taking a screen shot (phone) or photo of your screen (computer/ tablet)
- Individuals 5 years and older are eligible
- You will receive instructions by email and text message for how to prepare for your testing appointment (do not eat or drink anything for 30 minutes before your appt)
- Arrive no more than 15 minutes prior to your appointment; you must bring an ID
- All ASU/ADHS testing sites take saliva samples and use PCR testing. These are not rapid tests. Results are expected within 48 hrs
- ALL ASU SITES CLOSED DEC 23, 2020 JAN 1, 2021


